

RedLine Tailgate LED Light Bar Installation

Tailgate Light Bar Includes:

- LED Tailgate Light Bar
- 4-Pin Connector
- Adhesive Promoter
- Optional: Mounting bracket set

Part 1: Testing & Connecting

Trucks equipped with 4-pin trailer tow plug

Plug in the 4-pin adapter and test the running, brake, and turn signal lights. Then, proceed to "Part 2".

Trucks not equipped with a 4-Pin trailer tow plug

Hardwire the light bar into the truck's existing trailer tow wiring.

- o The chart below shows which wire on the tailgate bar powers each function
 - Yellow Wire Ground
 - ➢ Green Wire Running Light
 - Red Wire Left Turn Signal & Brake Light
 - Black Wire Right Turn Signal & Brake Light
- Match these functions with the wires on your existing tow socket.
 Your tow socket should have a guide that identifies which wire powers which function.
- If not, you can identify each wire using a voltmeter:
 - First, strip the wire
 - Activate a function (running, turn signal, brake, or reverse)
 - Use a voltmeter to read which wire is showing 11-12v.
 - > Repeat with the each wire until all wires have been identified
- o Once you have matched the wires, splice them together.
- o It's recommended to use heat shrink tubing (not included) to keep them waterproof

Trucks not equipped with ANY tow adapter.

Hardwire the bar into your existing taillights using the same methods above. You will need to wire the turn signals separately

Part 2: Wiring the Reverse Light:


- 1. Remove and unplug one of your tail lights
- Identify the reverse wire by activating your reverse lights, and testing each wire with a voltmeter to see which one reads 11-12v
- 3. Once located, take the Redline white wire and splice it into your reverse light


Part 3: Mounting the Bar

It is recommended that you test the bar for full functionality before mounting.

- 1. Unhinge and remove your tailgate.
- 2. Clean the area thoroughly. Any dirt or dust can reduce the strength of the adhesive
- 3. Prime the area with the Adhesive Booster provided in your kit.
- 4. Peel off the red protective film from the tape side of the bar
- 5. Apply the bar left to right, pressing firmly every 12 LEDs for 30 seconds.
- 6. Finally, test your lights one last time to make sure no wires came loose during installation.

TWO YEAR NON-TRANSFERRABLE LIMITED WARRANTY AND DISCLAIMER

OPT7 Lighting, LLC ("OPT7 Lighting") warrants to the original retail consumer purchaser, and not any other purchaser or subsequent owner, that this Product will be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of two:upars from the purchase date. this warranty does not cover any Product that is (1) installed incorrectly, or (2) damaged by collisions, vandalism, other accidents, or similar causes.

For a period of **two (2) years** from the date of purchase, at no charge to the Purchaser, OPT7 Lighting will repair or replace this Product if it is determined by OPT7 Lighting to be defective. After the warranty period, the Purchaser must pay all charges for parts and labor.

Coverage under this warranty is only valid within the United States, including its territories, as well as in certain other countries. Purchasers should check our website, **Error! Hyperlink reference not valid.** to determine the warranty coverage in the countries in which they are located.

OPT7 Lighting does **not warrant the installation** of the Product, which is the sole responsibility of the Purchaser. Installation should be done by licensed professionals. Improper installation may cause damage to the Product and any vehicle in which it is installed, and may cause burns and electrical injury to individuals. OPT7 Lighting's warranty does not cover any expenses incurred in removing Products that are defective or re-installing replacement Products in their place.

During the warranty period, to have the Product repaired or replaced, the Purchaser must return the Product, freight prepaid by the Purchaser, to OPT7 Lighting (but for customers in the contiguous United States, OPT7 Lighting will pay the shipping charges if any Product fails during the first thirty (30) days after purchase). The Product must be returned in its original carton or in a similar package affording an equal degree of protection. OPT7 Lighting will return the repaired or replaced Product, freight prepaid, to the Purchaser. OPT7 Lighting does not provide Purchasers with temporary replacement units during the warranty period or at any other time.

This limited warranty is non-transferrable and will automatically terminate if the original retail consumer purchaser resells the Product or transfers the vehicle on which the Product is installed. An "original retail consumer purchaser" is a person who originally purchases the Product, or a gift recipient of a new Product that is in its original packaging and unopened.
